### **RESIDENTS OF 313 - 323 NORTH 10<sup>TH</sup> STREET:**

The Borough requests your assistance by the following:

- Please access North 10<sup>th</sup> Street from the Planten Avenue side.
- Please park your vehicle on North 10<sup>th</sup> Street closer to Planten Avenue or on Planten Avenue if you will be *coming or going* during the hours of 5:00PM to 10:00PM on Tuesday, August 1.
- Please refrain from parking from 323 North 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Brown Avenue.

***The roadway will be closed off from the point of 323 North 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Brown Avenue.***

- Please access North 10<sup>th</sup> Street from the Planten Avenue side.
