## **RE: Notice of New Traffic Pattern on North 9<sup>th</sup> Street & North 10<sup>th</sup> Street** **Effective On or About Monday, April 10, 2017**

Dear Resident,

In December 2016, in response to residents' concerns, the Prospect Park Governing Body approved an ordinance that provides for a new traffic pattern during certain times on North 9<sup>th</sup> Street and North 10<sup>th</sup> Street between Brown Avenue and Planten Avenue. You are receiving this letter because you reside or operate a business within the area primarily affected by the traffic changes. This new traffic plan is being implemented to improve safety and traffic flow in the area during times of increased vehicular and pedestrian traffic that arise during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up times of Prospect Park School 1. The plan is the result of combined analysis by the Police Chief and Municipal Engineer.

A diagram of the new traffic pattern is on the reverse side of this letter and summarized as follows:

- No Right turn on North 9<sup>th</sup> Street from Brown Avenue going Northwest between the hours of 8:00AM – 9:00AM and 2:30PM – 3:30PM **while school is in session.**
- No Left turn on North 9<sup>th</sup> Street from Brown Avenue going Southeast between the hours of 8:00AM – 9:00AM and 2:30PM – 3:30PM **while school is in session.**
- No Left turn on North 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Planten Avenue going Northwest between the hours of 8:00AM – 9:00AM and 2:30PM – 3:30PM **while school is in session.**
- No Right turn on North 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Planten Avenue going Southeast the hours of 8:00AM – 9:00AM and 2:30PM – 3:30PM **while school is in session.**

As the new traffic pattern is implemented, traffic control measures and street signs will be in place to manage the traffic flow and minimize traffic impact as much as possible. However, please expect some delays as all pedestrians and drivers learn the new traffic pattern. Thank you for your patience during this process. We hope it will make the area safer for all.
